- Transfer Tracker:

 - A student who's transfer assessment was completed last year but their eligibility status should carry into this year will be viewable in any roster their eligibility affects
 - Go to Manage > Sports

- WIAA Staff are getting more questions related to NIL deals and what is acceptable
 - Staff have worked with Tacoma Public Schools to develop a toolkit for schools, students and parents as a resource
 - Will be posted on the website soon
- NIL is separate from acceptance of merchandise or in-kind gifts of \$500
- Students may enter into an agreement for any amount with a company
 - Students CANNOT promote the company in any way that connects them to their high school (ie. uniforms, school name, school in the background, logos or marks)
- Schools and programs cannot promote NIL deals as it may result in the loss of amateur standing for the student

HOT TOPICS - SMOKE

- Guidelines - Use for decision making
- Work with DOH and District
- May need to cancel or move indoors
- Rule 17.11.11 - Practice Accommodations
 - Minimum practices will not be waived
 - Use the step-by-step process
 - Moving or Rescheduling
 - 7 days of practice in a week
 - Practice on a Game Day

- We are still trending up overall
 - 2nd highest in Assoc. history*
- BUT Coaching ejections decreased
 - 41% were listed as District Employees
 - 24% were Certificated staff
 - 55 listed as head coaches
 - 52 listed as assistants or volunteers
- Still not receiving all ejection reports (20.1.2)
 - One school business day to report
 - All ejections are one contest
 - You can be more restrictive
- Reminder of Appeal Process
- Two new amendments for ejections

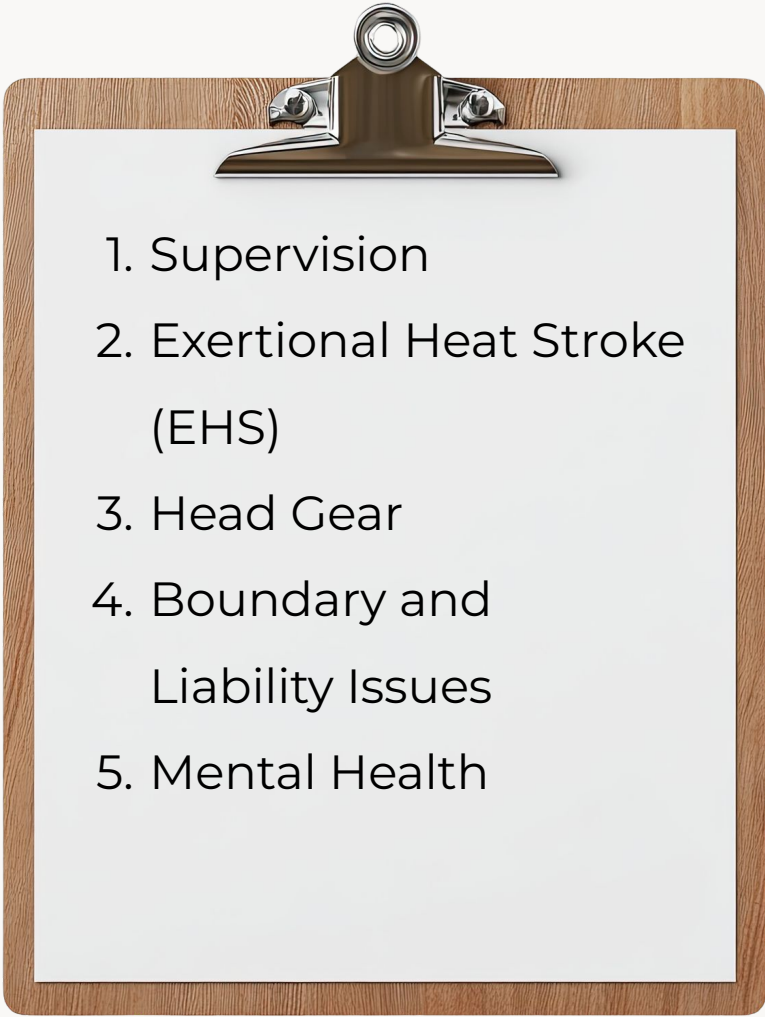

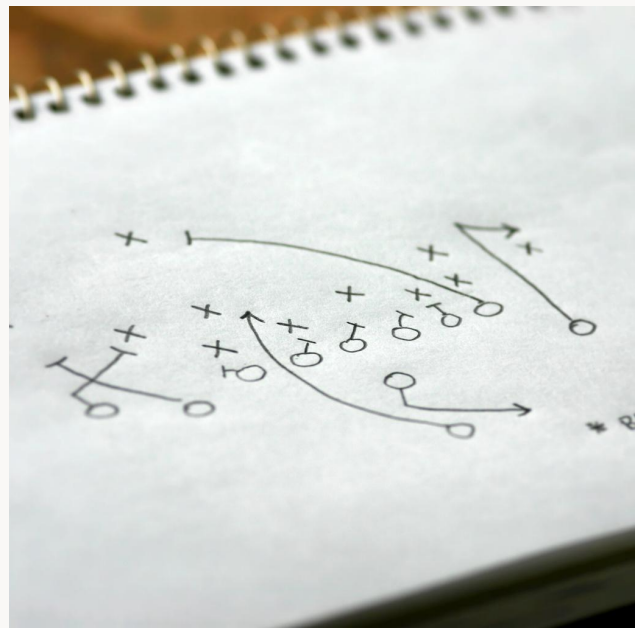

- Pre-game conference (officials, coaches, medical personnel, AD)



GAME PLAN

DURING EVENT

- Control access points
- Monitor restricted areas
- Verify credentials
- Assist spectators
- Monitor crowd behavior
- Communicate concerns immediately





GAME PLAN

AFTER EVENT

- Ensure officials and teams exit safely
- Secure equipment
- Complete facility walkthrough
- Report damages or issues
- Address “rushing the playing surface”

NFHS SPORTS MEDICINE ADVISORY COMMITTEE (SMAC)

- **Leading cause** of preventable death in high school players
- Most fatalities occur during the **first week of practice**
- 97% of cases involve **linemen**

PREVENTION

- **Progressive** workload increases
- **Early** recognition
- **Immediate** removal and evaluation of struggling athletes
